- 1. Infrastructure: The college building is a landmark in the city of Nagpur. The classrooms and laboratories are adequately furnished, with proper use of technology. College is suitably equipped to conduct online classes on virtual platforms. The auditorium 'Shalom' is one of the best in Nagpur and is used for various programmes and functions.
- 2. Courses: Areas of study in Science, Arts, Humanities, Commerce, Management, Biotechnology etc. are being offered at undergraduate to Post-graduate level, hence making it easy for students to gain knowledge and employable skills for their careers.
- 3. Students: Hislop College attracts students, both boys and girls from entire Nagpur District and is known for its leadership in quality education and extra-curricular activities.
- 4. Staff: Highly qualified staff is engaged by the college, dedicated to their teaching and are having excellent relationships with students. Many of the senior teachers also serve on the university forum adding to prestige of the college.

Employers' Feedback on Student Quality Session 2020-21




How would you evaluate the CORE COMPETENCY of the students on a scale of 1 to 5? 17 responses




How would you evaluate the SOFT SKILLS of the students on a scale of 1 to 5?





Teaching-Learning and Evaluation -Online Student Satisfaction Survey: Session 2020-21 (For UG and PG students)

Year 2020-21 being a pandemic year, teaching learning and evaluation was done by teachers completely online using various platforms and different ICT tools. Hislop College IQAC has taken the initiative to conduct a large scale online Student Satisfaction Survey on Online Teaching Learning and Evaluation from 11th to 14th June, 2021, to know students' opinion about online teaching-learning and how satisfied they are with it.

A Google form questionnaire based on 4-point scale was prepared which had some statements about teachers' parameters / qualities that are essential for effective teaching learning. The students were asked to rate the teachers of each Department on a 4-point scale; where score 1 stands for inferior and 4 stands for Superior on an ordered scale. The questionnaire was designed as Department specific and responses on 41 subjects were collected. The questionnaire was divided in two parts; the first part was the student information in which the students are supposed to fill the following information.

First part-Students' information:

- ✓ Student's College ID
- ✓ Student's email id
- ✓ Stream: Science / Arts / Commerce / CMC
- ✓ Category of student: UG / PG/ Diploma
- ✓ Gender: Male / Female
- ✓ Level of student: Sem-II / Sem-IV / Sem-VI/ Any other
- ✓ Medium of teaching of in the Course: English / Hindi / Marathi
- ✓ Name of Teachers' Department for which this feedback is to be filled (Here a dropdown menu was provided having 41 Subjects)

Second Part- Student Satisfaction Survey on online Teaching Learning & Evaluation:

The following General instructions were included in the Google form questionnaire for the student respondents.

Questionnaire has 18 statements / questions about your teachers of the chosen Department. Respond to each statement with deliberation.

- ❖ You have to assign rating to each sentence as your response between 1 to 4, where rating 1 stands for inferior (lowest) and rating 4 stands for superior (Best).
- ❖ In the last part of the survey questionnaire, under the category 'Any other remarks' you can mention suggestions, positives as well as weaknesses in the teaching learning and evaluation process if any.

(Here your response should be restricted to teaching learning process only.)

- The questionnaire is Department specific. So, remember that each time you are giving rating on teachers of a particular Department which you have mentioned in the first part of the survey.
- ❖ Note that you are not asked to write your name, so your responses are expected to be transparent.

The following were the 18 statements / questions included in the questionnaire.

- 1. The preparation of your teachers for the online class.
- 2. The syllabus of your course was covered / completed by your teachers in the online classes.
- 3. Your teachers were able to communicate with students in their online classes.
- 4. Your teachers explain the course matter clearly & stimulate interest in course topic through online mode.
- 5. Your teachers able to solve the difficulties of students in the subject topics in online mode.
- 6. Your teachers regularly engage their online lectures.
- 7. Your teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications in online lectures.


- 8. In online teaching learning-your teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of motivation..
- 9. In this online teaching- learning, your teachers encouraged you to participate in Curricular, extracurricular activities of college / department and in the intercollegiate Competitions.
- 10. Even during the lockdown due to pandemic, you were provided with enough opportunities to participate in extracurricular online activities.
- 11. What are the teaching platforms used by your teachers in online teaching? (Grid format options were suggested to them)
- 12. What are the teaching tools adopted by your teacher for online teaching?
- 13. Which method of online teaching is the best (most preferred) according to you among the following? (Common Options were provided to them)
- 14. Which method of teaching learning is better according to you? (online, offline, mixed)
- 15. According to you examination and studying more fruitfully is better in which pattern of teaching learning?
- 16. Online Unit tests / examinations are regularly conducted in the class by your teachers.
- 17. Which pattern of examination do you prefer?
- 18. How satisfied are you with your overall online teaching learning evaluation experience? (Rate on a 4-point scale: 1 being not happy ...4 being very happy).
- 19. Any other remarks: Give your positives / suggestions to improve the existing overall online teaching-learning evaluation process in your Institute.

A group of HODs and Coordinators of PG programmes was formed on What's App. The in-charge of the survey has taken care to brief the group of HODs on What's App regarding sending the Google form questionnaire link to their students' group. The link of the questionnaire was sent on HOD's group on 11th June 2021y at 10:00 am. The link was kept open till 14th June. In the span of 4 days (11th -14th June 2021) 3973 responses of students were received.

The following analysis was based on responses of 3973 students of UG and PG together belonging to Arts, Commerce, Science and CMC streams to the SSS on TLE conducted during 11th -14th June 2021. The overall average student satisfaction indices on statements (1) to (10) (Items 1 to 10) listed above about teacher's quality on a 4-point scale are calculated in the following table:

Noteworthy Concluding remarks on questions 11 to 18 listed above:

- ✓ Most preferred teaching platform preferred by Hislop teachers was MS Teams next followed by Google meet.
- ✓ The teaching tools adopted by most of the teacher for online teaching were PPT presentation, next followed by Teaching Online with laptop- white board combination and then a few preferred sending You tube videos.
- ✓ The response of students to the question-Which method of online teaching is the best (most preferred) according to you was that 44 % preferred teaching using PPT presentations and 32 % preferred Teaching Online with laptop- white board combination, 10 % preferred sending You tube videos and the rest opted for teaching with uploading pdf documents.

- ✓ Responses to- Which method of teaching learning is better according to you? were as follows: 40.3 % of the sampled students preferred offline teaching, and interestingly 44 % of them preferred combination of both which is noteworthy and the rest ie. 15.7 % students preferred online teaching.
- ✓ According to you examination and studying more fruitfully is better in which pattern of teaching learning? Responses to this question indicate that-40% were of the opinion that combination of both online and offline teaching-learning evaluation is a better method, where as 37.6 % of the sampled students felt that offline mode is better option for examination and teaching-learning.
- ✓ Interestingly the responses to the question- Which pattern of examination you prefer? resulted in 77.7 % of the sampled students preferring online MCQ format examination against the second option of Offline usual descriptive questions format.
- ✓ The average score assigned by students on- Online Unit tests / examinations are regularly conducted in the class by your teachers was found to be 3.39 on a 4-point scale.
- ✓ The average score assigned to the last question- How satisfied are you with your overall online teaching learning evaluation experience?- was found to be 3.30 on a 4-point scale.

Report of Student Mentors' Review Meeting held on 25th May, 2021

Hislop College Student Mentoring Cell conducted a virtual review meeting of its student mentors on Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, 25th May, 2021 at 3.00 p.m. Around 51 student mentors and 04 Core committee faculty members of SMC attended this meeting.

At the onset, convener of mentoring cell, Dr. Jyoti Shiwalkar welcomed the teachers and the students. She mentioned that this year has been exceptional and challenging for all and moreover it was student mentors' first experience of providing online guidance. The student mentors could not meet their juniors personally and had to rely on the digital platforms for mentoring. She further informed the students that this cell is a special initiative of Hislop College started almost 12 years back and has led to conflict free, disciplined and healthy environment on the campus over the years.

She specially congratulated the student mentor Achal Sonekar of B.A. II Sociology for having done remarkable work under the "Learn from Peer" scheme, an initiative of the student mentoring cell. She appreciated the work of all student mentors and said that almost all student mentors have submitted their filled-in mentoring formats to her by emails. Her speech was then followed by the review session of student mentoring, in which some student mentors from different streams shared their experience of online mentoring in the meeting. The student mentors were eager to share their experience.

Namisha Singh a student of B.A.II, History, (Hindi medium) said that although online mentoring was a difficult task she thoroughly enjoyed the experience and was glad to be given this opportunity.

Shanaya James a student of B.Sc. II, CBZ group described mentoring as a fresh and new experience. She told that she guided the juniors with respect to admission process, Time table and cleared all their confusions. She also provided the students with PDF of her old books as the book stores were closed and the students did not have access to notes.


Two student mentors of B. Sc. II Biotechnology, namely Chaitanya Gadekar and Shrushti Chipde shared their experience as different from normal. They tried experimenting with different ideas like conducting workshops, Science through Theatre etc. Rounak Pahuja, mentor of Statistics group described the juniors as a cooperative group and said that he loved being a mentor.

Akshar Panchakshari, another mentor from Statistics thanked the convener for giving him an opportunity to be a mentor. He commented that clearing doubts of the juniors also cleared his own doubts and gave him a better understanding of concepts. He mentioned sharing of resources, holding meets to explain technical issues related with University online examinations and other issues to be a part of his mentoring experience.

Kanak Agrawal from Commerce stream commented that mentoring was a wonderful experience, she tried to connect with her juniors, provided notes, explained the procedures for filling exam form among others.

Thereafter many student mentors raised their hands and shared their experiences namely Simrat Kour and Mriyam from B.Com, Dhanisha from Sanskrit, Akshat Rao from BBA, Ashley Mathew from BCCA and Nikita Choudhary from MCM. The student mentors in common described this virtual mentoring journey of 2020-2021 as memorable, providing them with a wider view of leadership and a valued personal experience.

Convener Dr. Shiwalkar then declared the session as open forum inviting the students to come forth with their positive as well as negative comments. Prajwal from Electronics and Anchal Bhatia from Psychology again shared their experiences.



The convener concluded the meeting, wishing the students all the best for their future. She asked the student mentors to fill a feedback form which was sent on their group later that evening and invited suggestions from the students for bringing improvement in the quality of the Institute.

At the end, the link for the issue of certificates to mentors was posted in the chat box for student mentors, which was followed by a virtual group photo of student mentors.

Feedback Analysis


In the feedback responses it was observed that almost all the student mentors have enjoyed their online mentoring activity.

According to all student mentors 4 types of mentoring sessions were mostly conducted by them for online mentoring activity. The favoured mediums of mentoring session are-

1) Online Group Sessions on MS Teams

- Personal Counseling
- 3) Textual messages on Whats app
- 4) Conducting video sessions with a group of mentees

The following diagram represents percentage wise classification of Student mentors using each of these methods:



All student mentors opined that their mentees were enthusiastic, curious and sincere enough to know from them as well as cooperative.

The following were the responses of student mentors on their experience of mentoring:

Question: What do you gain from this online student mentoring activity? Explain in your own words.



Student Satisfaction Survey on College infrastructure

Session 2020-21

The student satisfaction survey on college infrastructure was conducted for the session 2020-21 during 22nd June to 25th June 2021. A Google form questionnaire was prepared by setting questions related to college infrastructure and its link was sent on students' what's app groups. Responses of 1113 students were received. The analysis of these responses on 15 questions is presented below:

Out of 1113 students who responded, the following diagram gives the stream wise classific ation of students




Out of the total respondents 84% were from UG courses and 61 % were girls.

The respondents were asked to rate the college amenities by assigning a score on a 4-point scale (4 being highest- superb and 1 being lowest- poor) to their classrooms, Laboratories, Auditorium, Library, Parking facility, playgrounds, Drinking water facility, Rest rooms/ toilets as well as Library staff, administrative staff, security staff.






