

Dr. Roma Sarnaik Life Style Medicine Physician was the resource person. The session was conducted to promote positive lifestyle and behaviour change for managing physical and mental health of the students. Dr. Mousumi Bhowal Convener HISCAAN welcomed all the participants and conducted the session. Dr. Pratik Michael Vice-Principal and IQAC Co-Ordinator Hislop College gave introductory remark and highlighted the benefit of session which is to face the challenges in the world due to Covid-19 pandemic and technology. Dr. Razeka Khan introduced the Resource Person of the session.

Dr. Roma Sarnaik gave information about life style medicine which is a branch of medicine dealing with use of whole food dietary lifestyle, regular physical activity, restorative sleep, stress management avoidance of risky substances and positive social connection as a primary therapeutic modality for treatment and reversal of chronic disease. Through Power Point Presentation Dr. Roma highlighted the importance of physical activity such as Exercise/Yoga/Cycling/Walking for both physical and mental health which reduce the risk of hypertension, heart disease, stroke, diabetes, depression, anxiety and many other chronic diseases. She also tinted that academic achievement of the students also depends on physical activity which is associated with improved cognitive performance among students. She suggested students to take sound and quality sleep, proper nutrition with ample of water fruits vegetables and healthy diets instead of junk food. She recommended students to reduce use of oil, salt, sugar and also to reduce screen time. She also advised students to keep talking about their issues. At last, she gave a take home message to the students that the majority of the illness and death are caused by chronic/lifestyle diseases. These diseases are preventable as well as treatable. Regular physical activity along with proper nutrition, sleep and stress management works as an essential element for long term good health. Students enthusiastically asked questions in Q/A session related to physical and mental health to Dr. Roma and she also gave positive response to it. Hislop College Alumni Association (HISCAAN) organized a Training Module through webinar for students selected under the HOPE financial Sponsorship Scheme for the Session 2020-21. The focus this year was on soft skillsby Mr. Aniruddha Pathak. The two hour modules were conducted over two days on 5 and 6 March 2021.

Mr. Vijay Naidu President HISCAAN presented the introductory remark and highlighted that HISCCAN provides skills much needed in social life other than their conventional curriculum through various training modules. Dr. Razeka Khan formally introduced the guest speaker.

On day one i.e. 6th March 2021, Mr. Pathak explained the concept of soft skills which includes much more than personality development. He clarified that personality is only what is visible, what we do and how we behave. The major focus is always on what is visible but equally important are the things which are invisible but define our character. He explained these concepts through the example of Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj and Cricketer M.S. Dhoni. Character building is more important than to develop a personality. He insisted that we should focus on our strong points but at the same time we should not ignore our weak points but instead should work hard them.

He further explained that things which can be taught are called Hard Skills i.e. the courses or education that we take from educational institutions and their application is soft skill. It is a self-nurturing process by which we can strengthen our roots. He explained it with an example of the Chinese Bamboo,strongest bamboo in the world. It takes 5 years to grow and during this period it is totally invisible over the surface but it keeps on growing inside the soil and after five years within six months it grows up to a height of 100 to 150 ft. High.

The most important things to focus while working on soft skills are:

- ➤ Whom do you know and who knows you?
- ➤ When you are on the top, the world knows you, but when you hit the bottom, you know the world.
- We don't fall over the mountains, but over a small stones.
- > If you want to pick someone up, you have to bend first.
- ➤ The more you bend while climbing the mountain, the more erect you will be while coming down.

He explained that it is necessary to create a brand of one's name and for that one needs to stand out in the crowd. Setting a goal and working hard for it is equally important. Failures are be part of life, but one should not hesitate to take the decisions. Our actions speaks louder that our words so we have to be aware how we behave while interacting with people.

At last he explained about LION cycle which means Learning, Investment, Openness and Newness. So to develop one's character one should always be ready to learn. Secondly, one should invest time & work hard for that. Thirdly, one should always be open about what we feel or what we want. Lastly we have to be always ready to upgrade ourselves.

On second day, Mr. Pathak explained that to grow one should always come out of the comfort zone. He elucidated the OPEN cycle which means Observation, Patience, Empathy and Networking.

He explained the model through examples that are part of our everyday life. The qualities of patience, empathy and networking should be imbibed in our lives.

Students enthusiastically interacted with resource persons in both the sessions. As the modules were interactive there was active participation of the students thus helping in achieving the set objectives of the training module.
