7.1.9 Various activities in the Institution for inculcating values for being responsible citizens as reflected in the Constitution of India.

As part of Institutional Social Responsibility, the institution strives to inculcate the values amongst the staff and students towards making them responsible citizens of the country. The college also dedicated towards sensitizing the stakeholders and making them responsible towards a greener planet.

- **HISAR (Hislop Institute for Social Action & Research)**

As part of Institutional Social Responsibility, college runs HISAR Project at Pandhrabodi Slum. This ongoing project helps in imparting skill-based Training towards sewing to the girls and women of the slum with an objective to empower them. Help them towards maintaining an overall cleanliness of the slum. Making them aware about Hygiene and Health. Providing education to the children of slum. Providing them counselling and Rehabilitation support towards incidents of Domestic Violence and Alcohol abuse.

- **Celebration of National Days**

Every year Institute celebrates Republic Day and Independence Day on January 26 and August 15 respectively. The celebration is attended by Students, Teaching and Non-teaching Staff and invited guests. The event comprises of Flag hoisting with National anthem, patriotic song by students, address by the principal and the invited chief guest. The students and staff are made aware of the struggle of our freedom fighters and the importance of living in a free democratic country.

- **Constitution day**

Constitution Day is celebrated on 26th November every year. The programme initiates with Preamble reading of the constitution followed by lectures on the sensitization of students on responsibility towards the constitutional values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens.

- **Responsibilities and Ethics in Research**

The departments and cells organize activities for UG, PG and Research students with the objective to acquaint them with the research methodology, ethics in research in connection with their contribution to the society.

- **Environmental awareness**

The college through its environment cell and various departments sensitize the students on the preservation of the ecosystem and environment. Students are also sensitized to adapt green practices, conservation of natural resources, alternative source of energy and renewable energy.

- **Blood Donation**

Every year institute organizes blood donation camp as part of Institutional Social Responsibility.

- **Road Safety Rally & Street Play**

The students are encouraged to participate in the activities of spreading the awareness among citizens on social issues like road safety through rallies and street plays. The college has a policy for students and staff where the wearing Helmet is compulsory. The college also ensures that students have their driving license with them and the details are to be given during admission.

- **Cleanliness/Plantation drive**

Students consistently and regularly participate in the cleanliness drives on and off campus on several occasions including Mahatma Gandhi Jayanti on October 02, every year. Moreover,

students are encouraged for active participation in the tree plantation drives.

- **Induction of the students on values, rights, duties and responsibilities**
Students are made aware about the code of ethics, human values, rights, duties and responsibilities as a student and also a citizen of India during induction as well as other programmes throughout year.
- **Voter's day**
