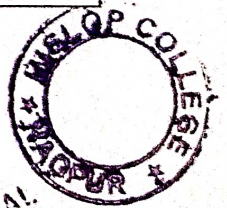

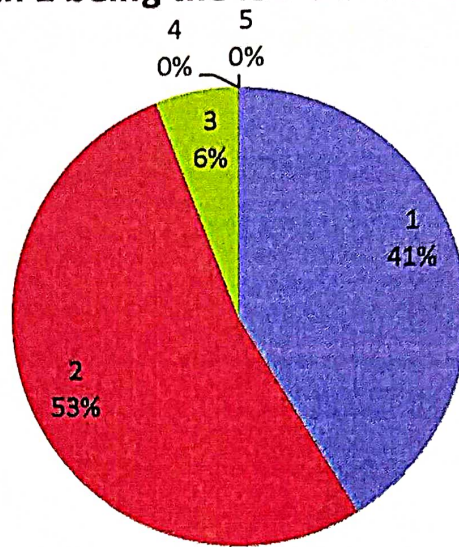

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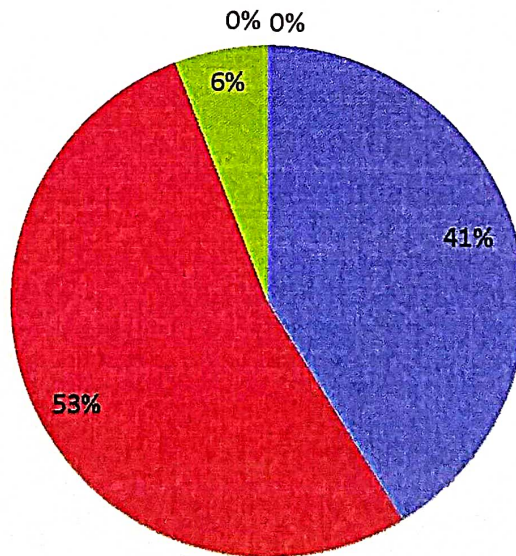

How would you evaluate the CORE COMPETENCY of the students on a scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being the lowest and 5 being the highest?

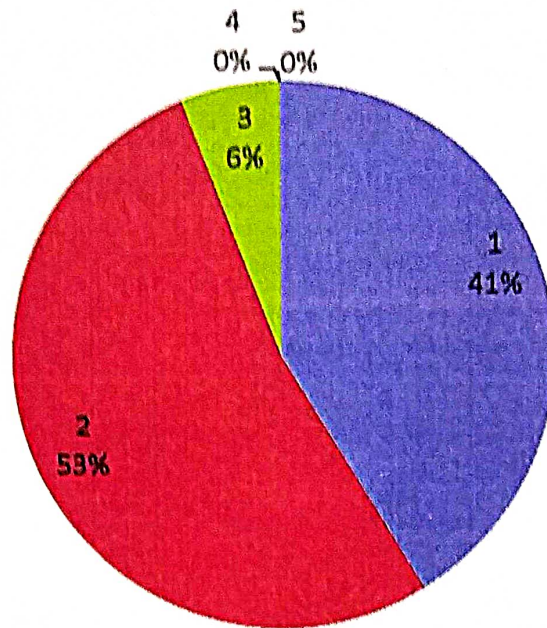

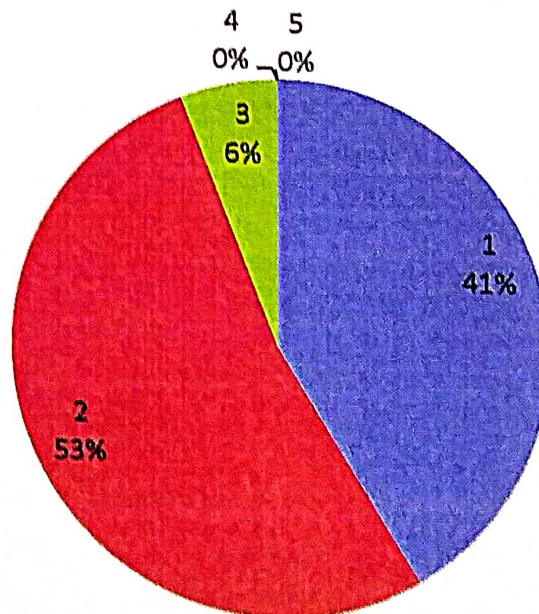
