




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The insects collected by the trainees from the field were pinned, stretched and dried. Trainees were grouped into five and each group curated the specimens from all the ten orders of insects.



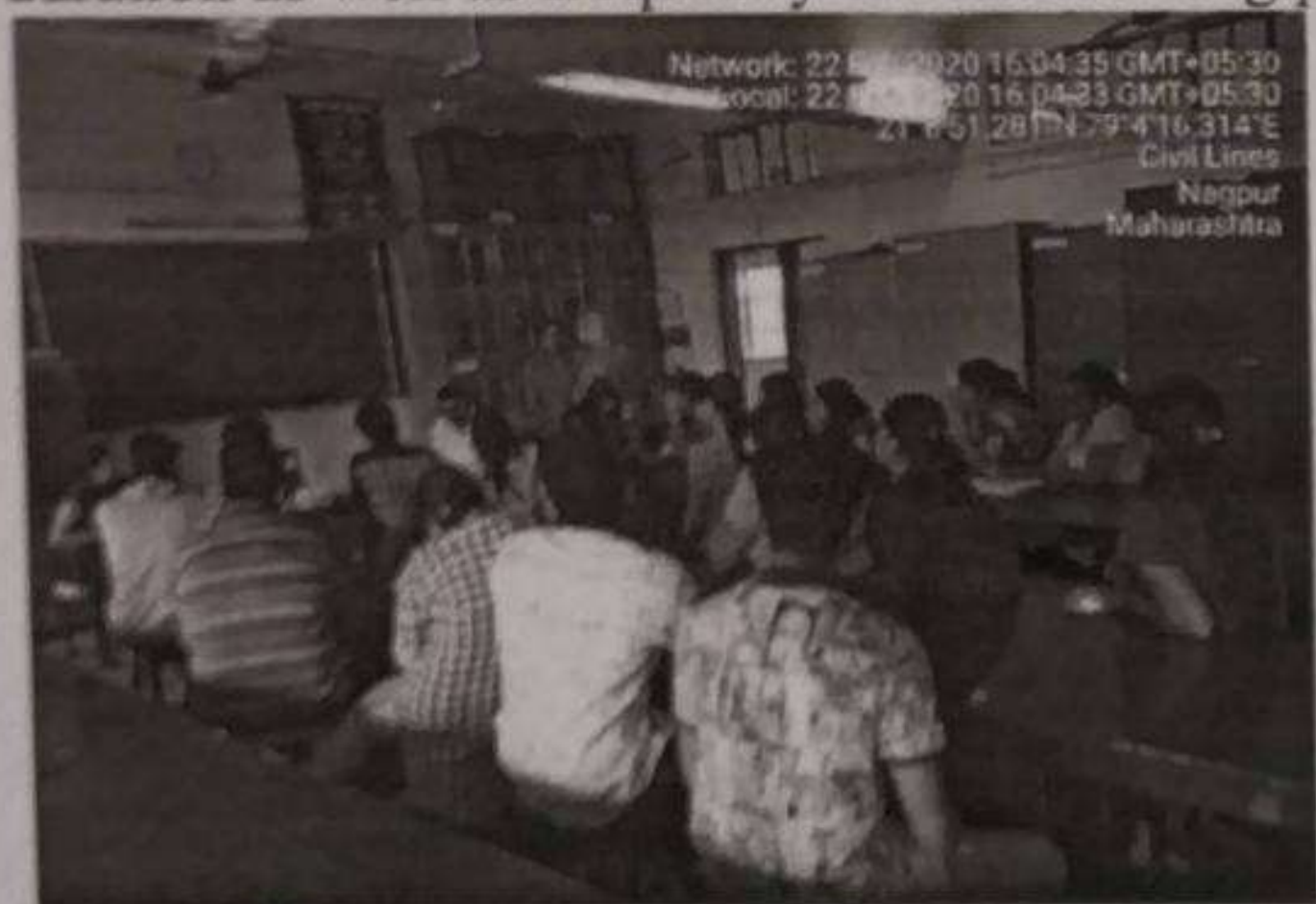

The dried and preserved insect specimens were identified till their families using the identification keys by matching the morphological characters.






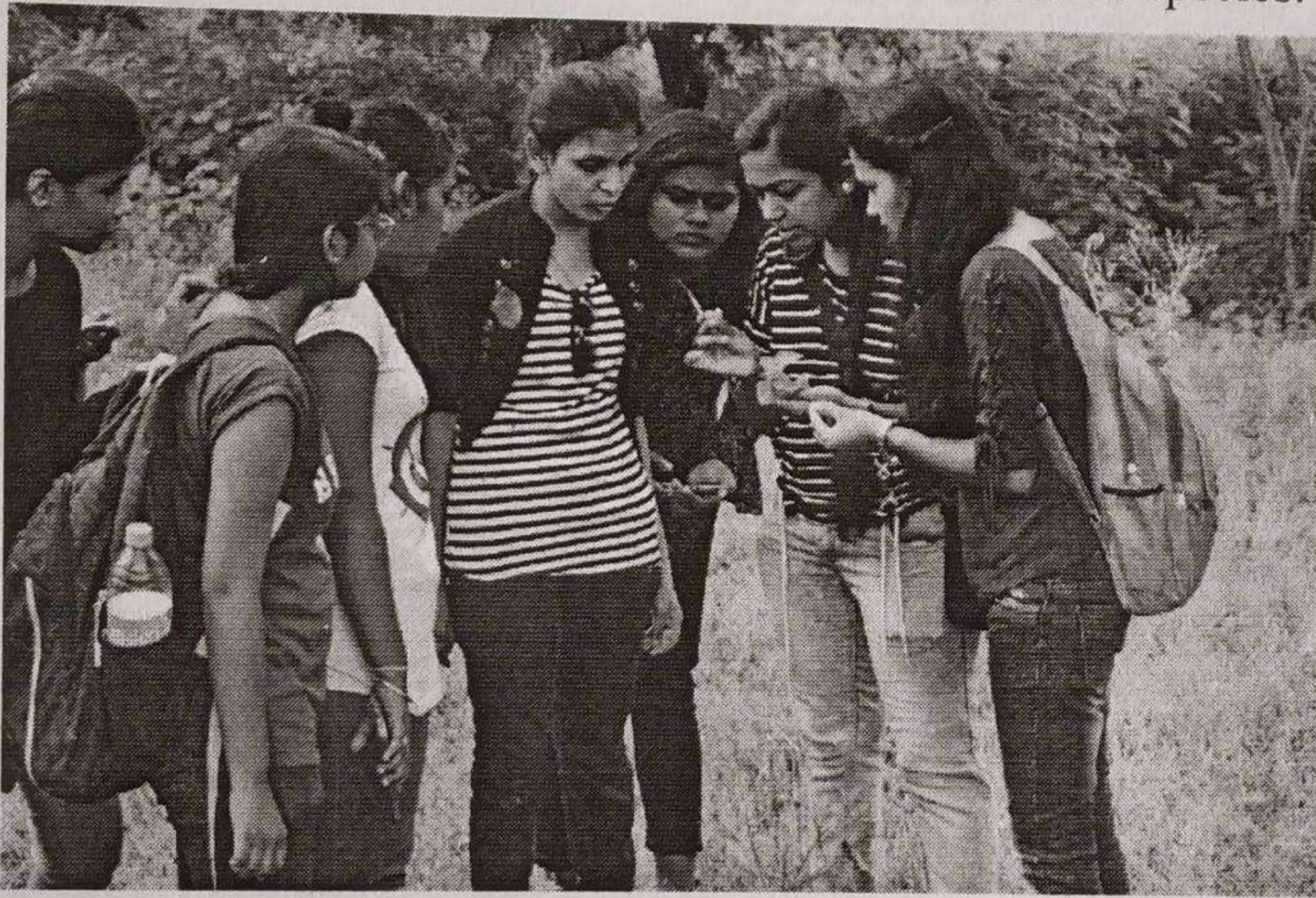
Pic.5.: Feedback by participants at Valedictory function. - Day 5 of Insect Taxonomy and Morphometry training programme.

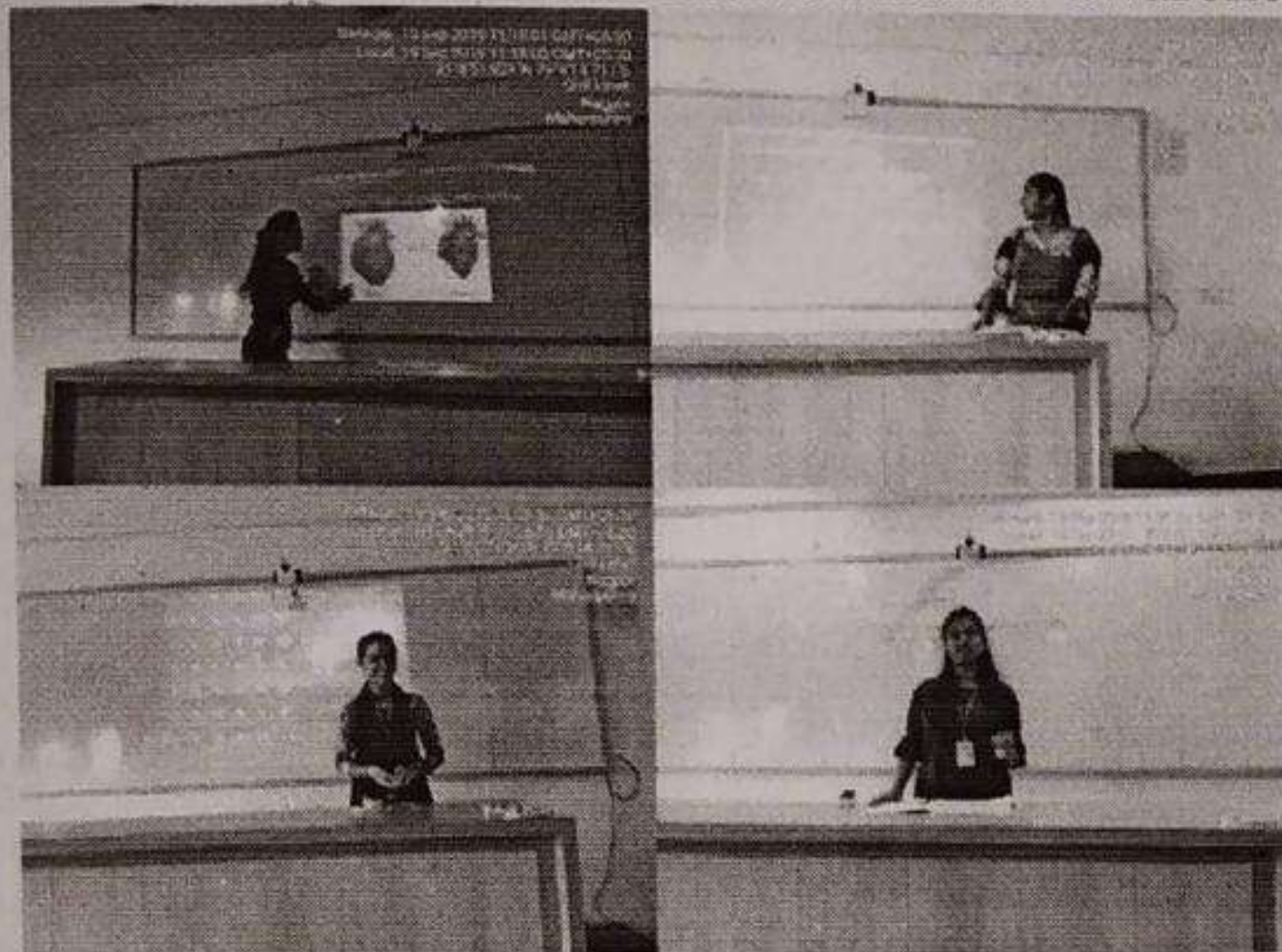
