## Visit to Excavation site at Kelzar, Dist. Wardha

25<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2019



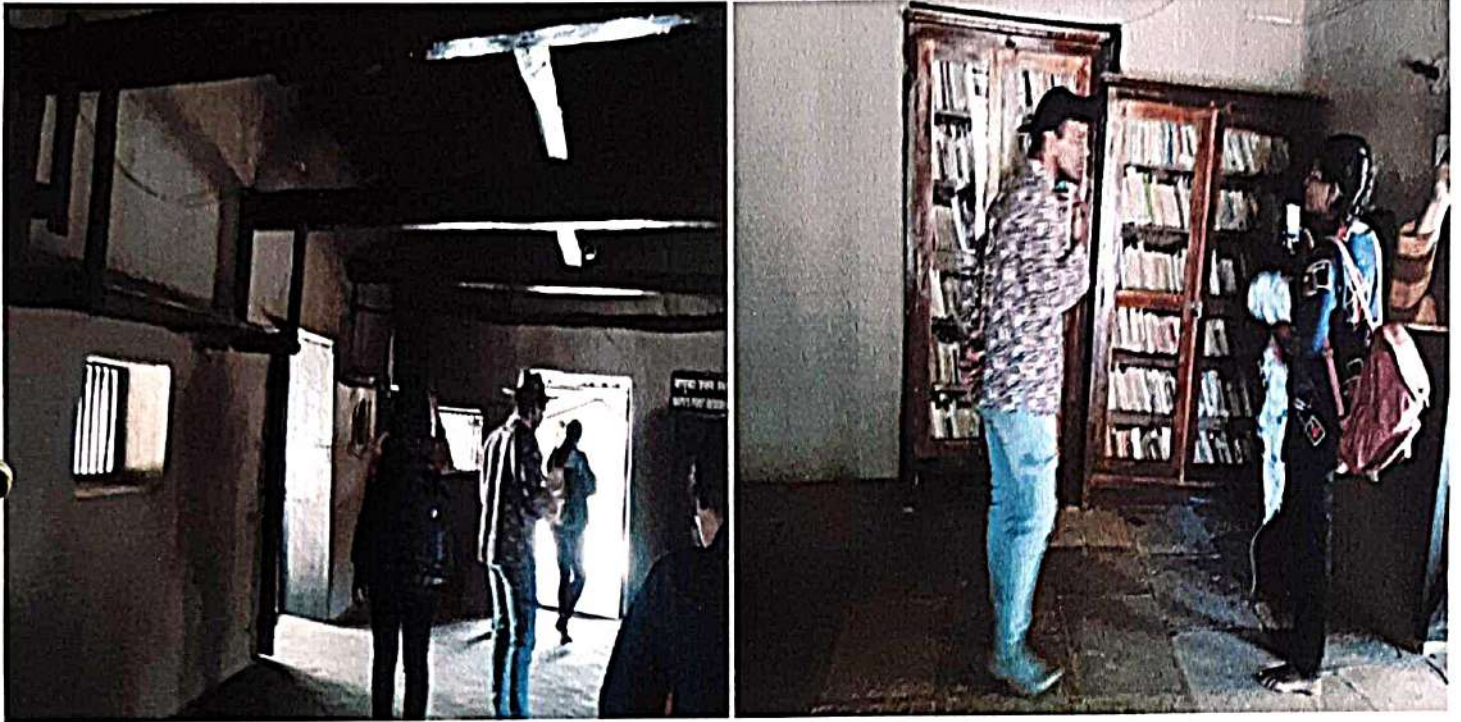
The whole idea of taking the students on an educational trip was based on holistic approach towards learning. The trip was organized by the Department of History, Hislop College on 25<sup>th</sup> Feb. 2019. It was to make the students aware of the heritage and to ignite in them the sense of protecting this heritage. Group of twenty five students, along with teachers, Dr. Mrs. Anjali Andrew and Dr. Mrs. Anjali Gaidhane, left Hislop College at around 8.00 am and reached the excavation site at 9.00 am. The excavation site was at Kelzar, behind the Siddhi Vinayak Temple, Dist. Wardha. While walking towards the excavation site, students encountered a Baoli, filled with fresh water. Dr. (Mrs.) Priti Trivedi, Director of the Excavation site was busy restoring the the Baoli they have found beneath the surface. Some inscriptions on the bricks have also been discovered. Excavations have also revealed steps reaching the Baoli and even the base of a temple to which it was attached to. Dr. Trivedi told that they believe the structure belongs to the Bhosla period. They have found idols of Jain Tirthakars. The temple found a few in the vicinity of the Baoli. The temple belonged to the Yadava period (13<sup>th</sup> -14<sup>th</sup> Century) as it had Hemandpanthi Architecture. The temple was certainly a Shiv Temple due to the fact that it had a Yoni with no Shivlingam and deserted idol of Nandi. Nandi was found inside a lake by some local villagers, adjacent to the temple. The temple is west facing. Moreover, there are the remains of its Amalaka and Pillars. The temple was probably destroyed by some invaders.

## Visit to Sevagram Ashram

25<sup>th</sup> February, 2019



Students along with teachers visited Sevagram Ashram on 25<sup>th</sup> February, 2019. The guide told that this place, Sevagram, was chosen by Miraben (Miss Slade) for Gandhiji because after leaving Sabarmati Ashram for Dandi March, Mahatma vowed to not return to Sabarmati until India attained Independence. All the expenses to built the huts for Gandhiji and later for Kasturba Gandhi and Mahadev Desai were borne by Gandhiji's fifth son (adopted) Jannalal Bajaj. In front of the Adi Niwas is a big ground which was still used for prayers. Adjacent to it, there are there trees. The first one (Neem Tree) was planted by Gandhiji himself, second (Babul Tree) by Kasturba Gandhi and third one by Vinoba Bhave. Ba's Kuti was the very place where Kasturba Gandhi breathed her last. It also has a glass chamber displaying Bapu's used blankets and Ba's Saree and jacket. The 'Akhari Niwas' contains Bapu's huge collection of books and this was the last place where he lived before being assassinated in Delhi. Near it, is the Bapu Kuti where Gandhiji used to entertain his visitors and go along with the office work. In the Akhari Niwas, we found Bapu's Khadau' his utensils, his personnel bed, message table, toilet and his other personnel belongings. There is also a cottage which served as a personnel office of Mahadev Desai. In one of the Cottages, one can find the Type-writer used by Bapu. It also has a Hotline Connection. Sevagram also has 'Nai Talim Premises' for Children. It also has a cow dung gas plant and Gauraksha Sangrahalaya.

The main purpose for the field visit was to get the students acquainted with Agro-Economics.

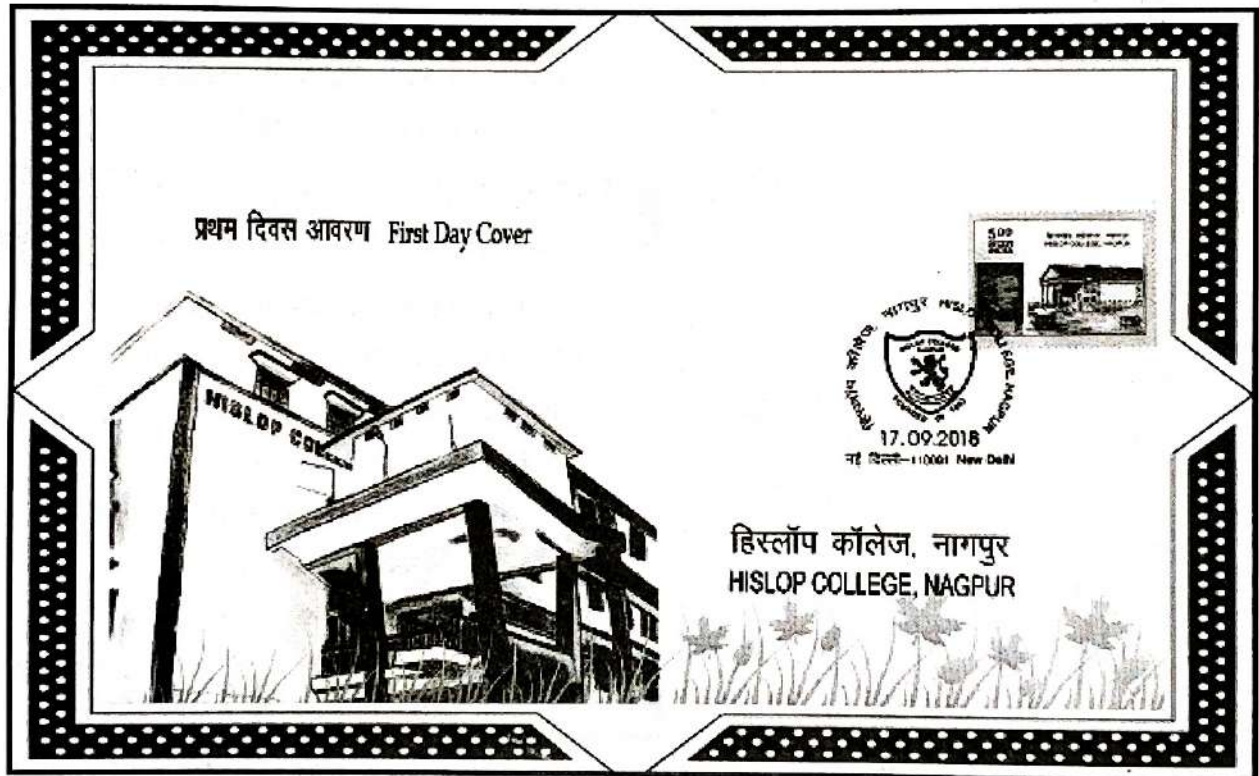

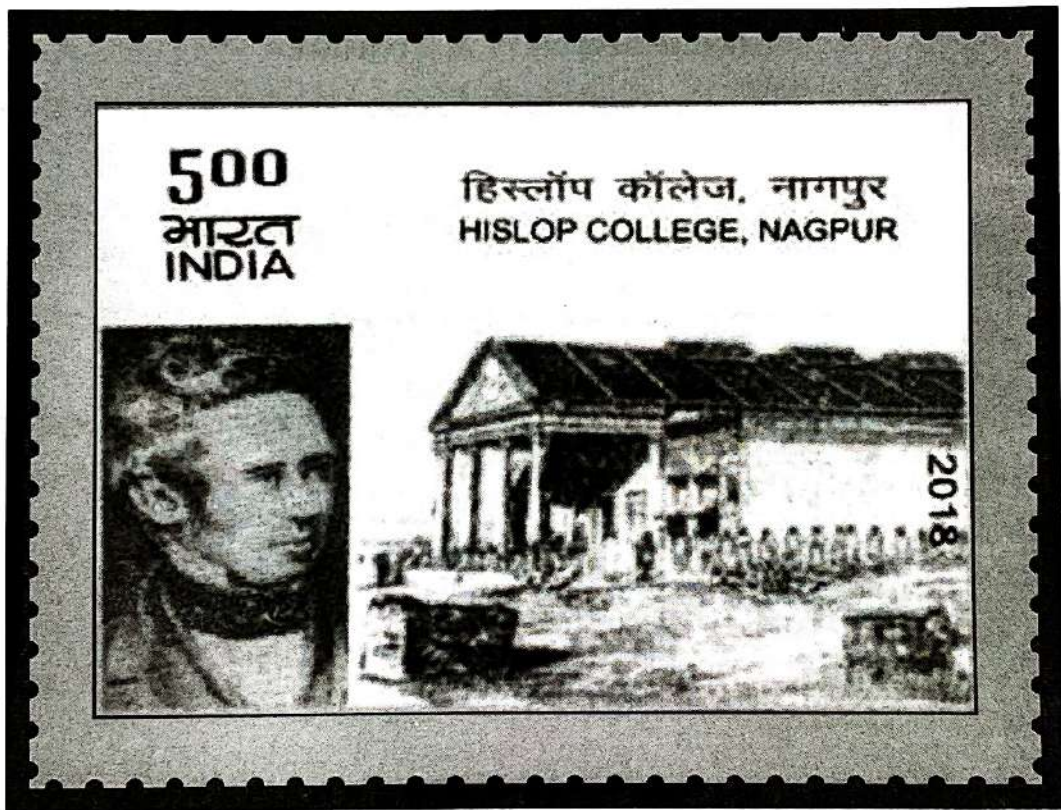

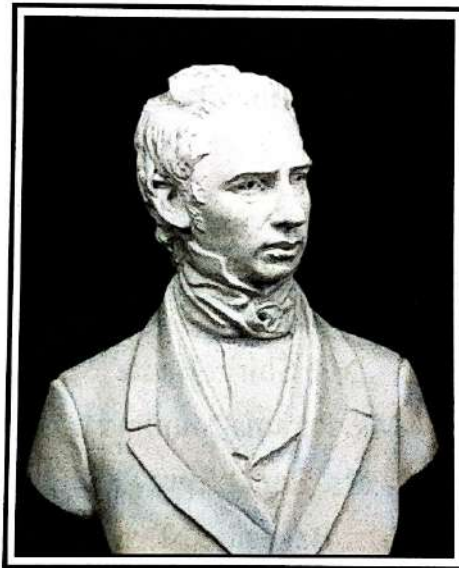
