UGC sponsored National Seminar on World Heritage Day'

"Role of Educational Institutions in the Conservation of Natural and Cultural Heritage"

The College organized a UGC sponsored National Seminar, "Role of Educational Institutions in the Conservation of Natural and Cultural Heritage" on 18th April, 2017 to mark the World Heritage Day. The Honorable Vice Chancellor of RTM Nagpur University, Dr. S.P. Kane was the Chief Guest and Dr. Preeti Trivedi, Professor and Head of the Department of Ancient Indian History, Culture and Archaeology, RTM Nagpur University was the Guest of Honour for the inauguration of the seminar. Mr. Kishor Divekar, Executive Member of Vidarbha Heritage Society, Nagpur was felicitated on the occasion for his outstanding contribution to the cause of preserving the culture and heritage of the country. Dr. Dipti Christian, Principal of the college welcomed the participants and elucidated ways in which Hislop College is playing its role in sensitizing its students, in particular, and the people in general about the importance of preserving and conserving the heritage and culture of the country. Dr. S.P. Kane in his address commended the iconic role played by the 134 year old institution in producing generations of students who have proved their mettle in various fields. Dr. Kane further noted that parents and teachers have a very important role to play because youngsters can be sensitized to something as intangible as culture only through their beliefs and experience and not merely through reading about it.

Dr. Preeti Trivedi in her keynote address expressed concern that the nature of our culture and heritage is extremely fragile in the face of modernization and development. She emphasized on the fact that our culture and heritage needs to be conserved so that we do not deprive the future generation of their natural inheritance. Dr. Monali Chakraborty, Conservation Architect, in her plenary address shed light on what the true definition of heritage was and the tools that teachers can adopt in order to promote heritage awareness among students. Mr. Pradyumna Sahasrabhojane, the President of Vidarbha Heritage Society, showed some rare pictures of the various heritage sites of Nagpur and explained the influence of diverse cultures, both indigenous and cosmopolitan, on the architectural heritage of the city. The participants later worked in groups and chalked out an action plan that they can adopt in order to encourage students to appreciate the rich culture and heritage of the country and sensitize them about its conservation and preservation.

The seminar was attended by 143 teacher delegates from various schools across the city and 64 participants from the college. The conveners, Dr. R J. Andrew and Dr. P. Shelke and the organizing secretaries, Dr. P. Michael and Dr. A. Yoel and the entire organizing committee worked hard for the success of the seminar.

61st All India English Teacher's Conference co-hosted by Hislop College

The 61st All India English Teacher's Conference was co-hosted by Hislop College in collaboration with Cenacle Journal, Forum for Creative Writers in English and The Association for English Studies of India (AESI). The Theme of the Conference was "Emerging Trends in English Language and Literature." 500 delegates from across India attended the conference. The technical paper reading sessions were conducted in the College. Dr. S. P. Kane, Vice Chancellor, Nagpur University, Dr Ved Prakash Mishra, Chief Advisor, Meghe Group of Institutions, and poet Dr Quaiser Khalid were the chief guests at the inaugural function. Eminent scholar, Dr Karien Gabriel from St Stephen College, New Delhi delivered the key note address, chaired by Dr R.N Rai from Benaras Hindu University. The other noteworthy resource persons were Dr Amrit Sen from Vishwabharathi University, Dr Subhir Dhar from Kolkata, Dr Nibhir Ghosh from Agra, Dr Preetha Vasan from Bengaluru and Dr. Prantik Banerjee from Hislop College, Nagpur. Mr. Vijay Phansikar, the Chief Editor of The Hitavada was the Chief Guest in the Valedictory Programme and Dr. (Ms) Dipti Christian, Principal of Hislop College was the Guest of Honour.



Heritage and Culture Sensitization Programmes

In commemoration of its Heritage status, Hislop College has launched a drive this academic year 2016-17 to sensitize students about the importance of conserving the rich culture and heritage of the country. The following activities were included in the drive:

Certificate Course in Heritage and Cultural Studies

The College has conducted Certificate Course in Heritage and Cultural Studies for two successive batches of students in 2016 (25th Aug-15th Oct) and 2017 (7th Mar-25th Mar). Each batch comprised around 50 students. Hislop College is the first college in Central India and under Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University to offer this course and the course has drawn a lot of interest among students and the general public at large.

Study Tours: As part of the certificate course, students were taken on a study tour to the following places: 1) Central Museum, Nagpur 2) Historical sites such as Mansar, Nagardhan Fort and Ramtek Temple on 1 March, 2017. 3) Ubali in Kalmeshwar Taluka on 16 March, 2017. 4) Chikaldhara and the sites nearby Gawilkar Fort, Devi Point and Mukhtagiri Temple.

Heritage Walks and Rallies: As part of the drive to spread cultural awareness and sensitize the children and youth about the historic heritage sites in and around Nagpur, the College organized a number of heritage rallies and walks. Efforts were made to take the campaign for heritage conservation to the schools. More than 350 students of St. Ursula Girls' High School, Bishop Cotton School, Gardiner High School and Hislop College, Nagpur took part in a rally on 11th February, 2017. A second rally was also organized with 73 participating students of St. Ursula Girls' School, St. John School, Bishop Cotton School and Guru Nanak High School on 18th March, 2017.

Tribal and Folk Dance Festival : Hislop College in association with the South Central Zone Cultural Centre (SCZCC) organized a "Tribal Folk Dance Festival" which involved a wonderful spectacle and colourful pageantry of indigenous dance forms of Central India on 18 and 19 March, 2017 at Hislop College, Nagpur. The newly appointed Mayor, Mrs. Nanda Jichkar, was the Chief Guest on the occasion.

Heritage Exhibition : A heritage exhibition was organized in Hislop College in association with the Vidarbha Heritage Society for the benefit of students and the general public. Also, restoration and conservation of rare books and materials is going on.

Awareness On Cervical Cancer

Hope
