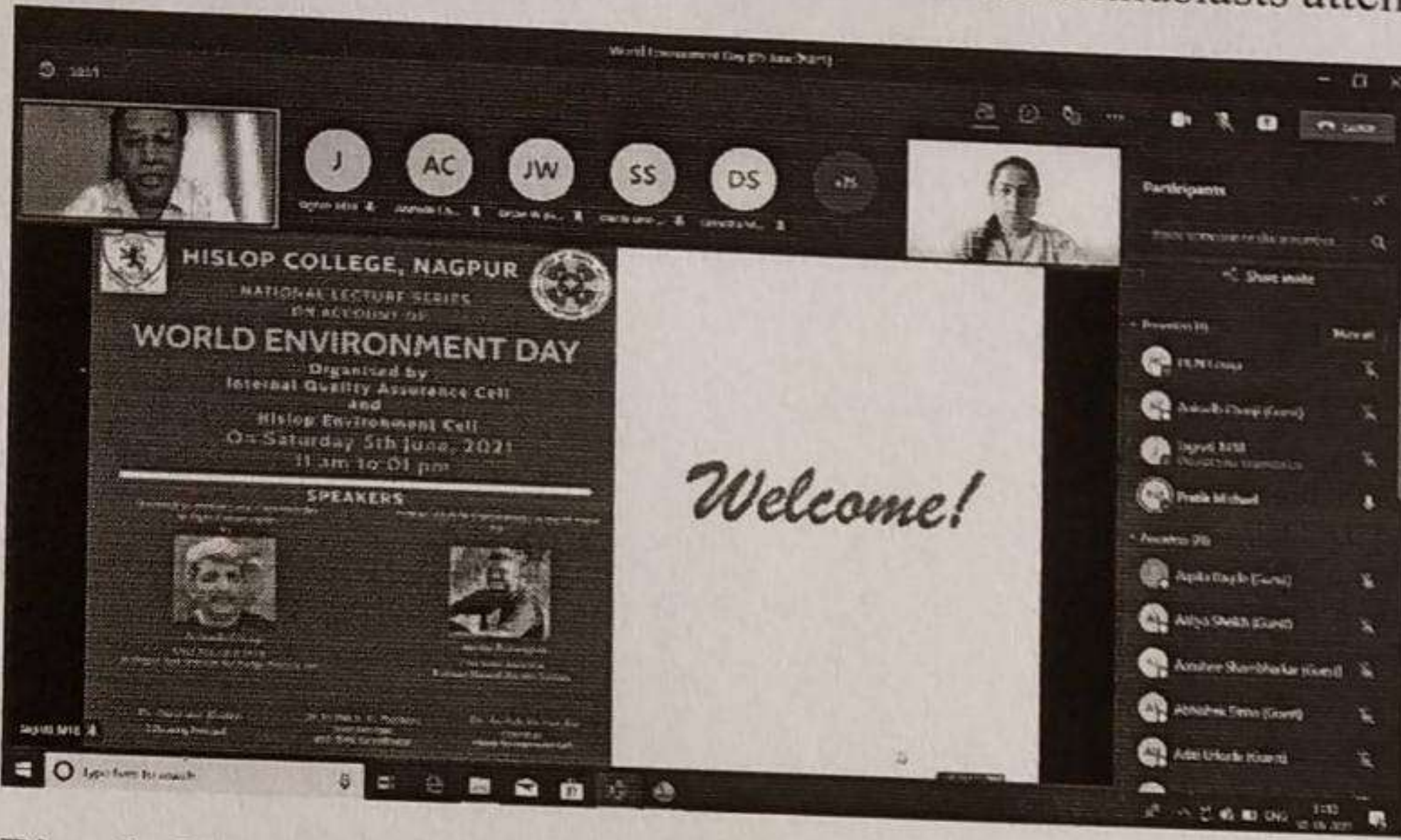

iii) World Environment Day – 5th June 2021

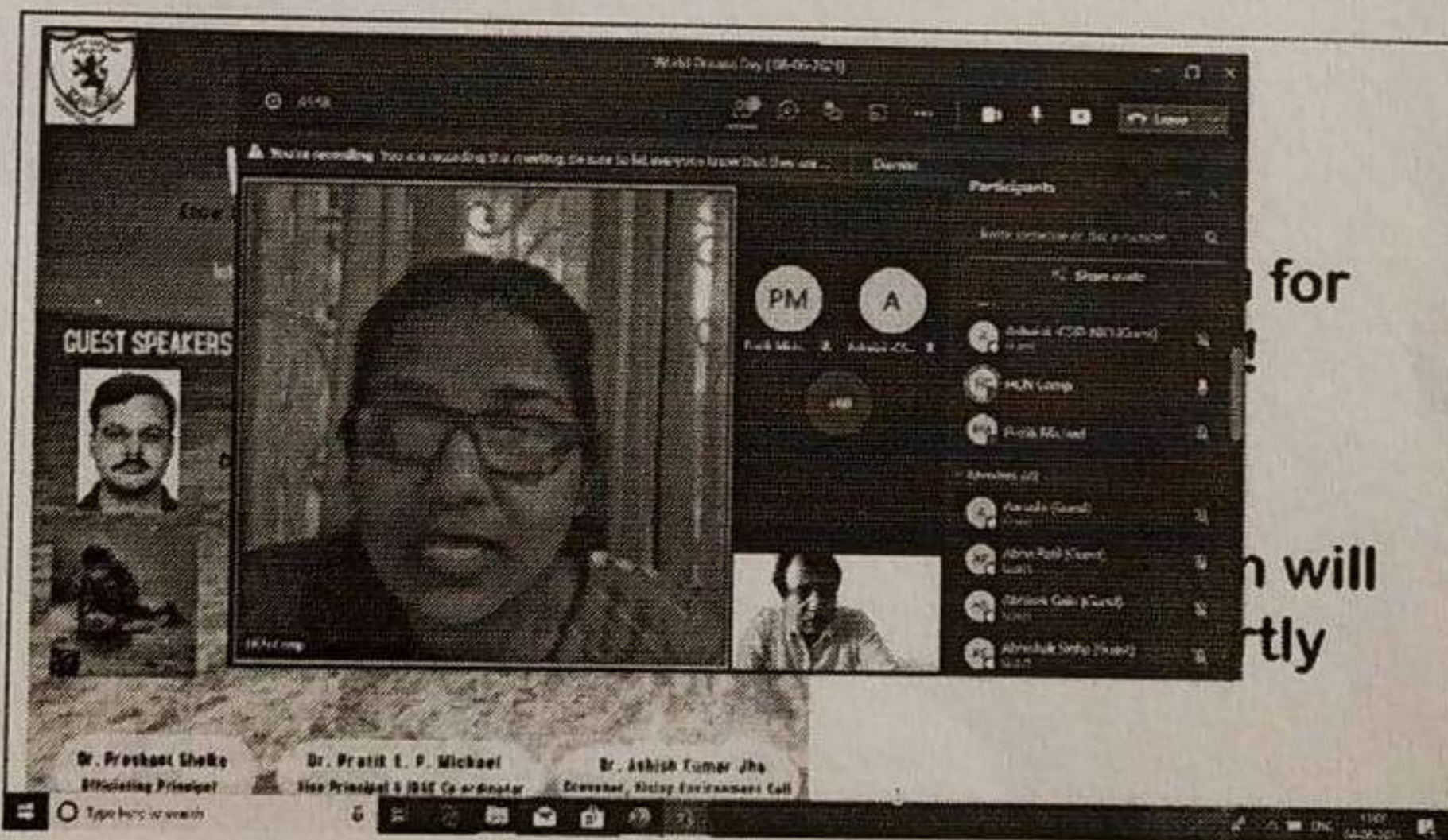
